

Notice about Head Lice

Early detection of head lice is important. Head lice eggs can be identified as white specks. Head lice lay several eggs each day, which hatch and grow into larvae to adults, rapidly increasing. Therefore, check your child's hair daily, detect them early, and treat and remove them immediately to prevent further spread.



How to prevent head lice:




Air out and beat the bedding well. Wash pillowcases and sheets frequently.











Wear a cap when entering the pool.


More than 5 minutes


Check your child's hair daily.



\POINT!

For infected clothes, towels, and sheets, soak them in hot water (above 60° C) for at least 5 minutes before washing. This kills both adult lice and eggs.





If head lice are found, use lice removal medication and a finetoothed comb to remove them.





Head lice can spread among family members. It's important to treat all family members simultaneously.
